#### **Jack Stephens** – ASHRAE Manitoba President – 1966



ASHRAE Manitoba Past President Jack Stevens died September 8, 2009 at age 83. Born in Winnipeg in 1926, he graduated from Daniel McIntyre Collegiate and furthered his education by taking drafting courses. In 1953, Jack married his high school sweetheart, Siv (Anderson), had a couple of daughters, enjoyed many laughs and good times with his family. Jack's competitive spirit was well known. He played football in Mexico City and was a proud alumni of the Winnipeg Blue Bombers (1945). An all-star

basketball player, he played for Paulin's in the 1950's. He enjoyed sand volleyball at Grand Beach and was a long time member of Elmhurst Golf Club.

After various jobs, Jack started his own business, Airmaster Sales which he managed so well that after 14 years he was able to retire (at age 50) and spend winters at his home in Boynton Beach, Florida and summers at Grand Beach with his wife. At 50, Jack took up tennis which he played until his passing.

Jack had not been active in ASHRAE Manitoba in recent years, but occasionally attended Past Presidents Night. He was notable for his friendly smile and his thoughtful, gracious and humorous contributions to the supper table conversation.
